 - How to involve the most marginalized communities and people and where to meet?
 - How to have a significant impact without promising something you can't deliver?
 - How to co-produce knowledge when information is deliberately withheld because certain subjects are politically dangerous or because of the political climate (patronage, fear of repression)?

- **Description:** "Co-create one online story map, with the story for every local Fairville Labs. The story map will be updated with collective mapping and co-production of proposals at the end of the WP3."
- **Due Month:** early June

2 types of production:

- a/ **Online story map** (home page) > to be produced by commonspace, with feedback from the FvLabs
- b/ **Fairville Labs' Stories** > to be produced by each of the 9 FvLabs

3a/ Online story map

Needed :

- **1 photo** (or sketch) to be transmitted by each FvLab (early May)
- **a presentation text** for each FvLab,
 - > first draft by commonspace (around 1200 characters, based on 4 sources), content: challenges encountered, main objectives, project partners, key stages...
 - > review by the FvLabs teams (early/ mid May)

Question: target audience (cf. Glossary, Toolbox)

3b/ Fairville Labs' Stories

- **Objective** : to tell the fairville lab story, create a narrative (*raconter, mettre en récit*)

> A « warm » and subjective content, an embodied story (*un récit incarné*)

N.B.: Building on the experience of the FvLabs: be able to discuss environmental justice or urban planning with non-specialists (workshops, feedback sessions, communication tools...)

Content, 2 main options:

- the whole process with different steps (chronology) and/or aspects (thematics/ issues/ places/ communities) > selecting the most appropriate sequencing
- focus on a specific aspect (significant moment, specific topic, community...)

3b/ Fairville Labs' Stories

- **Medium** : what you want, what fits best! (a « carte blanche »)

Only **3 characteristics**:

- the result must appear online,
- it can be updated (it will be with further steps & results : « collective mapping and co-production of proposals »)
- It should be as creative as possible.

3b/ Fairville Labs' Stories

Examples:

- a series of pictures with text
- a comic strip
- a series of video interviews
- a photonovel (*roman-photo*)
- a story-map
- an illustrated timeline
- a graphic facilitation board (sketchnote)
- a succession of annotated pictures
- diagrams
- a hand-drawn poster with links...

2.e/ Landfill and open dumps

We are close to one of the largest landfills for household waste in Europe: Fyli, located in West Attica, a few kilometres from the centre of Athens. Waste is present throughout the area, beyond authorised sites, in **numerous illegal dumps**. These sites support a wide range of economic activities.

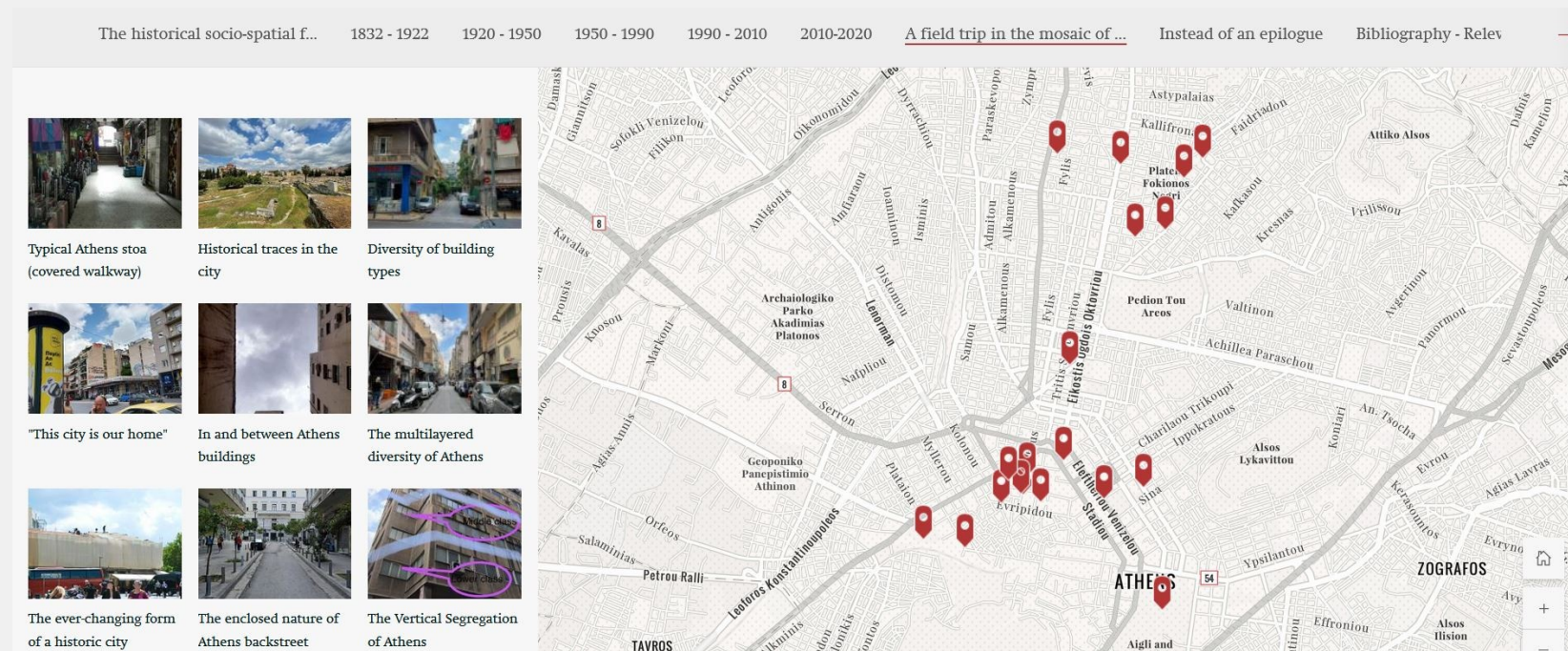

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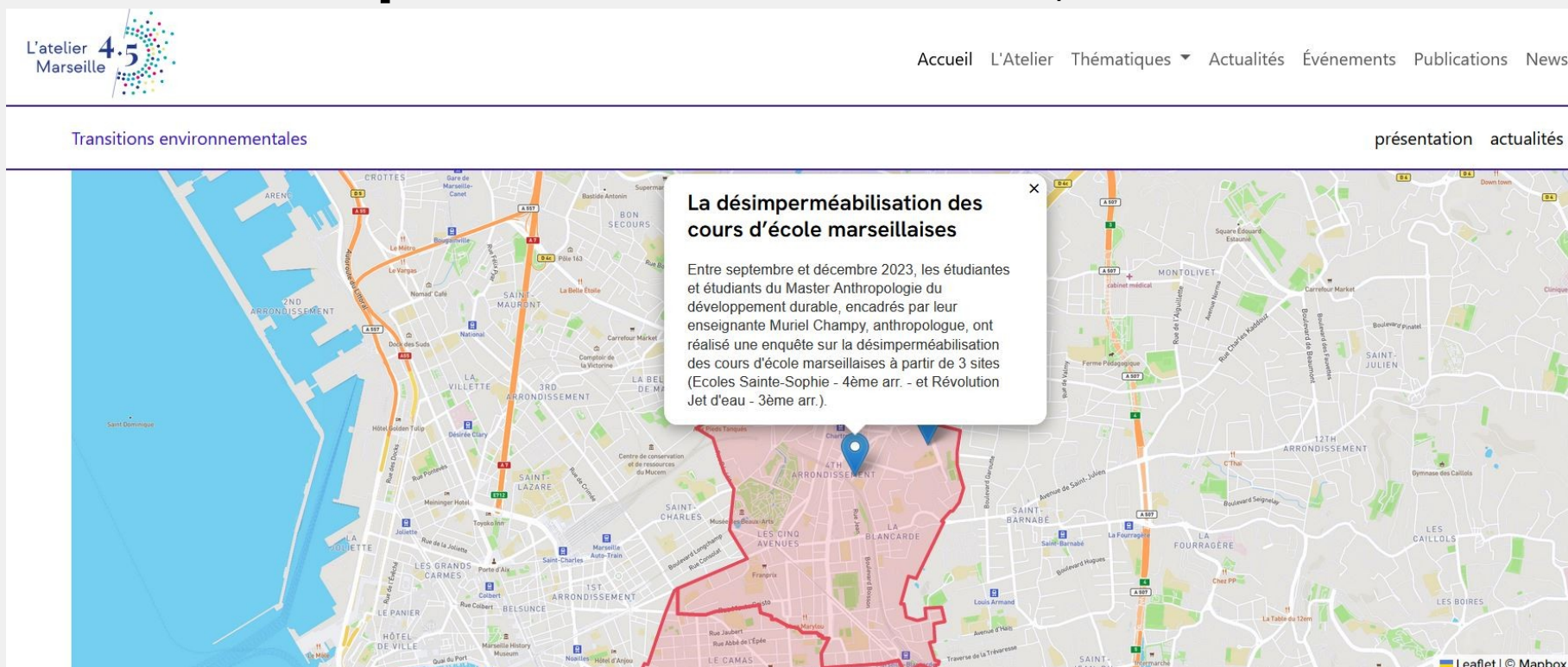

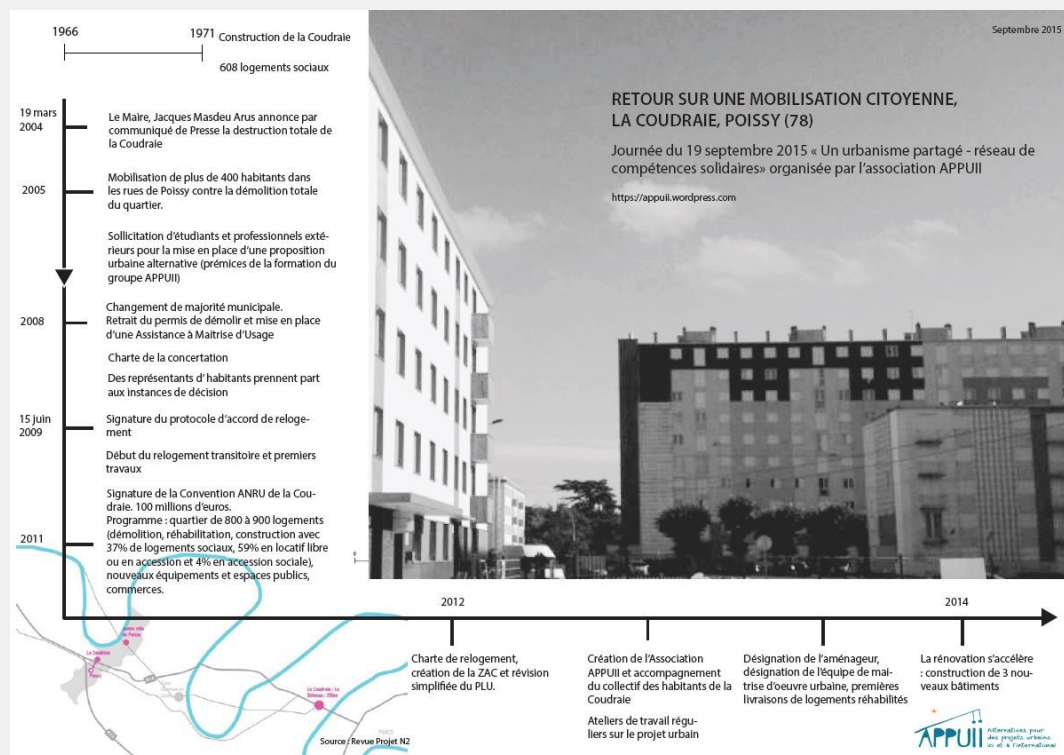

A BRIEF HISTORY OF TECHNOLOGY



1970

The first Apple computer was released in April 1976. This was the first computer readily available to the general public. For the most part society was pretty "green" to the whole concept.



1980

1990

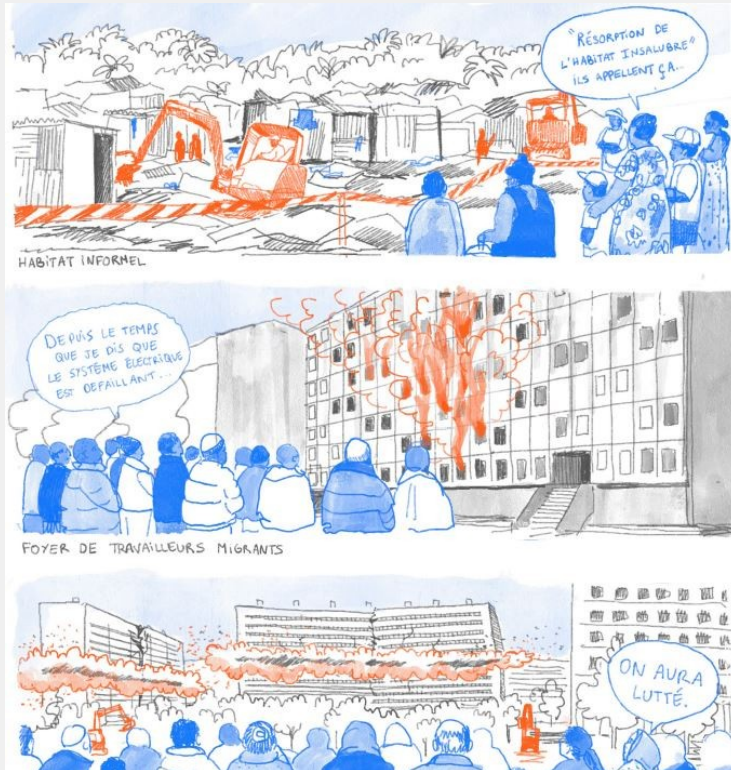
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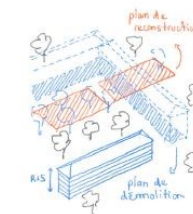
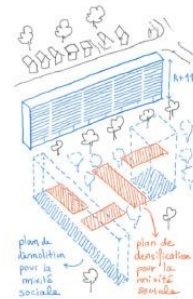

Quatre grands types de projets urbains



28 projets de rénovation urbaine financés par l'Agence nationale de la rénovation urbaine (ANRU).

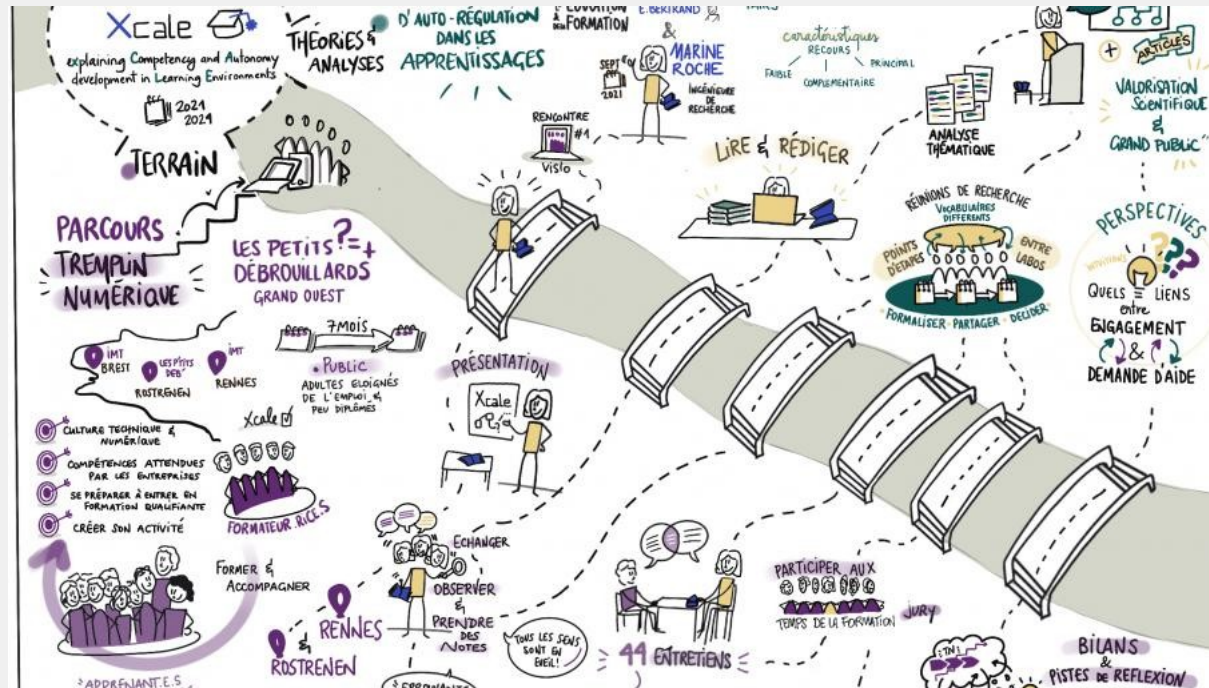
Depuis 2003, ces projets ont été menés dans plus de 1000 quartiers populaires, d'habitat social ou privé. Ils se caractérisent par des objectifs standardisés et des interventions récurrentes dont la mise en œuvre est adaptée selon les sites. Pour favoriser la « mixité sociale », diversifier l'habitat et permettre la valorisation immobilière, ces projets prévoient la démolition et la réhabilitation de logements sociaux, la construction de logements privés, la recomposition des espaces publics, la transformation des équipements et des commerces.

5 projets de rénovation urbaine privée dans des quartiers d'habitat social. Ils ne sont pas financés par l'ANRU mais suivent les mêmes objectifs et prévoient le même type d'interventions. Ils sont menés directement par des organismes HLM, des promoteurs ou des aménageurs privés, à distance de l'État local et des municipalités. En se passant des fonds de l'ANRU, ils s'affranchissent aussi des exigences de cette agence sur la co-construction des projets.

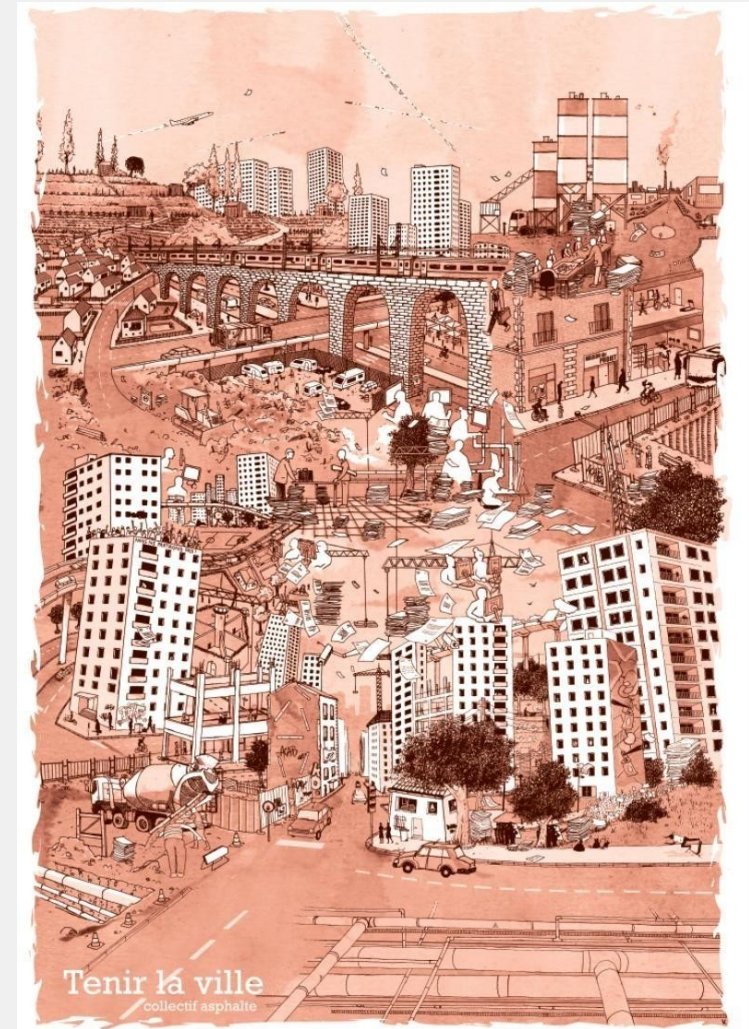
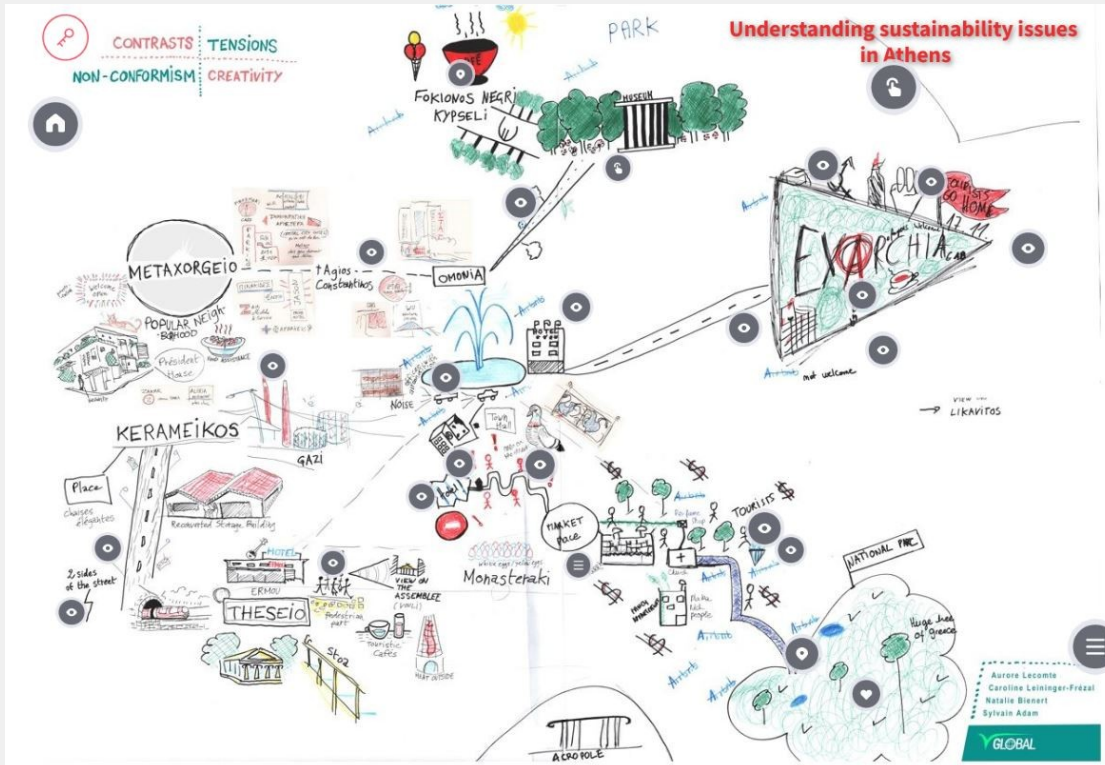

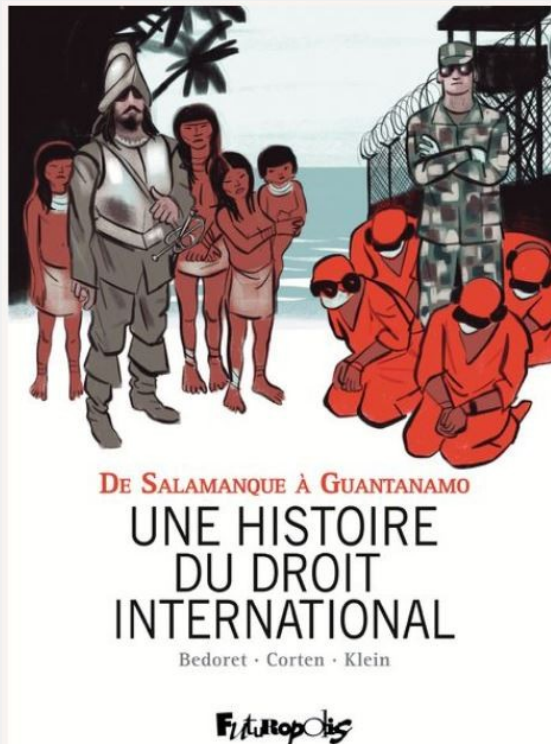
